



Harrow Primary Schools' First Key Stage 2 Results

Staff and students have been working incredibly hard to perform well in the school's first entry into national end of year examinations. I am delighted to announce that the results were exceptionally good with all students performing above teacher expectations and indeed above national results. Please note the National results in the table below are for 2013 as it's too early for 2014 to be published.

In effect in all but reading all of our students entered for KS2 SATs achieved above the national expectation for their age, indeed some were only 1 or 2 marks from a Level 6.
