



Harrow Primary School: Key Stage 2 Results, 2015

Staff and students have been working incredibly hard to perform well in the school's second entry into national end of year examinations. I am delighted to announce that the results were exceptionally good with all students performing above teacher expectations and indeed above national results.

In effect in all but reading all of our students entered for KS2 SATs achieved above the national expectations for their age, and a Level 6 in Grammar, Punctuation, Spelling and Maths. These national comparisons are with regards to 2014, as 2015 data is as yet unpublished.

 B is awarded if a pupil is working below the level assessed by the tests
 N is awarded when no level is awarded
